

CONTEST RULES **“Forky Scavenger Hunt”**

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

The company Euro Disney Associés S.A.S, SIREN 397 471 822 RCS Meaux, with its registered office at 1 rue de la Galmy, 77700 CHESSY (hereafter referred to as the ‘**Organiser**’), is organising Contest (hereafter referred to as the ‘**Contest**’) on a its dedicated App “Forky Scavenger Hunt” **from June 18th to June 29th 2019** (hereafter referred to as the ‘**Closing Date**’) to which the following rules apply.

ARTICLE 2: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION

The Contest is free of charge, open to any individual, with the exception of members of the Organiser’s team and their direct family members.

To participate, the Participants need to:

1. Download the App on the Android and Apple stores, on their personal mobile phones
2. Launch the App
3. Fill-in the Contest form within the App, including their title, first name, last name and e-mail address (Profile)

In order to be approved, each participation has to be complete, meaning all the fields the form must be filled. Any Profiles that are found to be incomplete, incorrect, fake or in contravention of the present rules will be disqualified from the Contest.

All participants who filled their Profile on the App will participate to the Contest (hereafter referred to as the ‘**Contestant**’).

A Contestant can only create Profile or may be disqualified from the Contest. Disneyland Paris will be able to check all the necessary information and will independently determine whether a Profile seems to have been created several times by comparing the elements provided within the Profiles.

ARTICLE 3: CONTEST DETAILS

The Contest consists in a draw of among the Profiles who regularly submitted their participation.

ARTICLE 5: SELECTION OF WINNERS

On July 13th 2019, a selection of Profiles will be drawn by the Organiser, in order to designate 40 winning players (hereafter referred to as the ‘**Winners**’).

Contestants selected as Winners will be contacted by email by Disneyland Paris with the confirmation of the nature of their prize bundle within 1 month after the Closing Date, subject to the Organiser having had the opportunity to perform the necessary checks to ensure that potential Winners have complied with the necessary rules and criteria, where applicable.

Winners must confirm their acceptance of the corresponding prize bundle within 10 days of receiving the aforementioned confirmation message and provide the Organiser with appropriate delivery details (first name, surname and postal address). Failure to respond within 10 days will result in the prize being returned to the prize pot.

There will be only 1 Winner per household, with same name and address.

No Winners' names will be provided by telephone, post, email or any other means of communication other than email.

ARTICLE 5: DESCRIPTION OF PRIZE BUNDLES

The following prize bundles are in the prize pot:

40 prize bundles including:

- 1 Forky talking Forky figurine (value: 19,99€)
- 1 Forky & Woody duo figurine (value: 12,99€)
- 1 Buzz Lightyear pen (value: 3,99€)

Total bundle prize value: 36,97.

ARTICLE 6: DELIVERY OF PRIZE BUNDLES

Prize bundles will be sent by recorded signed-for delivery to the postal addresses that the Winners have provided to the Organiser. In the event that the Winner is not at home when delivery is attempted and that they should fail to collect their prize bundle within the time frame specified by the relevant postal service, the prize bundle will be returned to the Organiser and considered to have been forfeited.

The Organiser cannot be held responsible in the event of any mail and/or prize bundle sent to a Winner being misplaced en route to the recipient's address for reasons beyond its control. Neither can the Organiser be held responsible in the event that a Winner's and/or the Overall Winner's contact details should change if it has not been informed of this change.

The prize must be accepted as it is and cannot be transferred, resold or exchanged for another object or for monetary value, nor refunded.

In the event of unavailability of the prize bundles mentioned in the Article 5, the Organiser also reserves the option to substitute a prize with a prize of an equal or greater value, still around the Toy Story theme.

ARTICLE 7: LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Participation in the Contest implies a knowledge and acceptance of the characteristics and limitations of the internet, particularly regarding technical performance, response times for viewing, querying or transferring information, risks of interruption and more generally the risks inherent in any connection and transmission on the internet, the lack of protection of certain data against possible misuse or pirating and the risks of contamination by viruses circulating on the network.

Consequently, the Organiser can in no circumstances be held liable, with this list not being limiting:

- for the transmission and/or reception of any data and/or information on the internet,
- for any malfunction of the internet preventing the smooth running and functioning of the Contest,
- for a failure of any receiving equipment or communication lines,
- for the loss of any paper or electronic mail and, more generally, for the loss of any data,
- for the functioning of any software,
- for the consequences of any virus, bug, anomaly, technical failure,
- for any damage caused to a Contestant's computer,

- for any technical, hardware or software failure of any kind whatsoever, preventing or limiting the ability to participate in the Contest, or having damaged a Contestant's system.

It is up to each Contestant to take all appropriate measures to protect their own data and/or software stored on their computer equipment from any damage. The connection of any person to the Site and the Contestants' participation in the Contest is done under their own complete responsibility.

Given the characteristics and limits of the Internet, particularly regarding technical performance, the Organiser reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to change the Contest at any time, to shorten it, extend it, stop it or remove it, without this giving right to compensation or indemnity for any potential Contestants, in any capacity whatsoever.

ARTICLE 8: RULES COMPLIANCE

The Contest rules apply to all Contestants; participation in this Contest implies full acceptance of these rules, which will be assumed for any Contestant participating in the Contest.

The Organiser reserves the right to take legal action against anyone who has acted fraudulently, or attempted to do so.

In the case of a breach by a Contestant, the Organiser reserves the right to automatically remove that Contestant from any further participation, without the latter being able to make any further claims.

The Organiser will not however incur any liability of any kind vis-à-vis the Contestants due to any fraud potentially committed.

ARTICLE 9: DISPUTES – OBJECTIONS

Any controversy or claim relating to this Contest will be taken into consideration within two months following the Closing Date.

Any practical difficulties in applying or interpreting these rules shall be settled independently by the Organiser.

It should also be borne in mind that these Contest rules have been translated to English for information purposes only, for Contestants who do not understand French. In the event of a dispute or disagreement, only the French version of the regulations shall be considered valid.

ARTICLE 10: APPLICABLE LAW

These rules are subject to French law.

ARTICLE 11: FILING AND CONSULTATION OF RULES

This Contest rules can be fully viewed at any time on the App.

They are also available from Studio Services (the information point for visitors to the Walt Disney Studios Park) or the concierge desks at the Organiser's hotels.

A copy of the rules can be sent out free of charge to anyone requesting a hard copy. This request must be submitted in writing to Euro Disney Associés S.A.S, Service Marketing Direct et Internet – Social Media, BP 100, 77777 Marne-la-Vallée Cedex 04. The postage charges incurred in submitting such a request will be reimbursed upon written request submitted at the same time as the request for the rules, together with the relevant bank details, and based on the low-priority postal tariff in force at the

time the request is received. Only one request will be granted per household with the same name and the same address.

The full French version of the rules is filed at SELARL EVIDENCE, a company with a bailiff's office at 15 bis avenue du Maréchal Foch, Chelles (77503).

ARTICLE 13: REIMBURSEMENT OF ENTRY FEES

Any Contestant can obtain a reimbursement of the charges they have personally incurred in order to enter the Contest, on the basis of a fixed reimbursement corresponding to the cost of a mobile connexion to Internet data , i.e. €0.10/minute incl. tax, lasting 3 minutes – the average time it takes to enter the Contest - by submitting their request in writing. Participants who subscribed to unlimited data connexion on the mobile phone will not benefit from any reimbursement, as their subscription is contracted independently from their participation to the Contest, given the fact that their use of the App won't trigger any additional fees to them.

his reimbursement request must be submitted in writing to Euro Disney Associés S.A.S, Service Marketing Direct et Internet – Social Media, BP 100, 77777 Marne-la-Vallée Cedex 04, together with the supporting documentation outlined below, at the latest 60 days after the Closing Date (as postmarked).

The postage and copying charges incurred in submitting such a request will also be reimbursed upon written request submitted at the same time as the request for reimbursement of the entry fee, based on the low-priority postal tariff in force at the time the request is received and at a rate of €0,08 incl. tax per photocopy.

Only one request for reimbursement of entry fees will be considered per Profile.

The Contestant must submit the following documentation in support of their request:

- A separate sheet stating their forename, surname, postal address and date on which they entered the Contest
- Their bank details
- A photocopy of their mobile Internet data bill that clearly shows the charges they are seeking to have reimbursed

Only charges actually incurred by the Contestant will be reimbursed. These conditions notably exclude plans offering unlimited Internet access and entries made using the Internet-user's monthly allowance.

Furthermore, the Organiser reserves the right to perform any checks and/or request any documentation it may deem necessary and to pursue any relevant legal proceedings where necessary.
